Kyrgyz people value and keep their traditions, the festivals are held to unite the nation and show their traditions and customs. During this tour you will see the exhibition of birds of prey (golden eagle, falcon), berkutchi (hunters) performance, demonstration of hunting skills of birds, archers' performance, exhibition of Kyrgyz greyhounds Taigan, master classes in crafts, national cuisine, performance Kyrgyz traditions, national games. You will be able to take part in the process.

- Watch ancient hunting with Golden Eagles on horses with Taygans;
- Do light hikes along the magnificent Tian-Shan Mountain ranges;

Itinerary

Day 1 Bishkek- Tamga (350 km, 5-6 hours of driving)

Meeting with a guide and driver in Bishkek. Transfer to Tamga along the southern shore of Issyk-Kul lake, that is considered to be the second largest mountainous lake in the world on the altitude of 1607 meters above the sea level. We call the lake “the pearl” of Kyrgyzstan. On the way we will stop not far from Tokmok town (60 km) and have excursion to Burana Tower, a place on the Great Silk Road dated to 11th century.

Upon arrival to Tamga dinner and overnight in the yurt. (Meal: D)

Day 2 Tamga – Bokonbaevo (50 km one side)

After breakfast transfer to the Festival. Here in the Festival, we will see the demonstration of hunting with a Golden Eagle; folklore show; exhibition and sale of handicrafts and souvenirs; tasting of Kyrgyz cuisine. After the Festival we will come back to the yurt camp in Tamga. Dinner and overnight at the yurt camp.

(Meal: B/L/D)

Day 3 Tamga – Kochkor (200 km, about 3-4 hours of driving)

After breakfast we will drive to Kochkor. On the way we will visit the canyon “Fairy tale”. The canyon was named because of its bizarre rocky landscape, which for many years has been transformed by erosion into amazing sculptures and formations. Some formations look like The Great Wall of China and you can also find other formations that look like snakes, dragons, sleeping giants and even whole castles. From the canyon you can see a majestic panorama of Lake Issyk-Kul and snow capped mountains. One-hour walking there. Dinner and overnight in the hotel. (B/-/D)

Day 4 Kochkor – Son- Kul (150 km, 3-4 hours of driving)

After breakfast transfer to the mountainous lake called Son-Kul, the lake is considered to be one of the highest lakes in the country, it is situated on the altitude of 3016 meters above the sea level and is a famous summer pasture for the local people, who come here every summer with their cattle and families and stay in the traditional nomadic housing called yurt. In the afternoon a light walking to the lake. In the evening the cook of the yurt camp will show us “Manty” show, Manty is a traditional central Asian dish, made of dough, meat and onions, those who wish can cook together the Manty. Dinner and overnight in the yurt. (Meal: B/L/D)

Day 5 Son - Kul - Bishkek (420 km, 5-6 hours of driving)

After breakfast transfer to Bishkek.

Upon arrival to Bishkek is end of our services.

- Supplement for airport pick – up / drop off – is 40 USD (car for 1-3 pax);
- Supplement for full board (3 lunches and 1 dinner) – is 50 USD per person;
- Supplement for Folklore Program in Bishkek – is 90 USD per group;

Additional information:

Level of difficulty: There are no difficulties on the route.

Conditions: It is necessary to bring warm clothes, walking boots, rain coat and etc. Weight of personal things is not limited.

Health: If you have any specific sicknesses, you need to bring own first aid kit with necessary medicaments.
